Our membership requirements include:

- A Bachelor's degree in music from an accredited college, university or conservatory (or the equivalent)
- Degrees obtained outside the U.S. require an equivalent to a U.S. bachelor's degree in music, documented with a special Foreign Credential Evaluation Report
- A degree emphasis or four years of individual study at a college level in the desired Primary Instrument or Subject
- Minimum of two years teaching experience in the Primary Instrument or Subject
- Compliance with MTAC Bylaws
